LESSONS:

“**Pedestrian Safety Basics**”: Students learn basic safety rules by writing and drawing specific rules, then by playing a Jeopardy-like game to review them.

“**Neighborhood Sensory Walk**”: Students get to know their own neighborhoods by observing them with their five senses.

“**This is the Way We Go to School**”: Students compare and contrast how their parents got to school, and then read a book that introduces how children from around the world get to school.
