Off-road e-motorcycles are **ILLEGAL** for students and are **NEVER** permitted on public roads!

Common e-motorcycles include:

Talaria



Segway

What's the difference between an e-bike and an e-motorcycle?

E-motorcycles have a throttle and can reach 80+ MPH

E-motorcycles have an electric motor >750 watts

E-motorcycles are ONLY allowed to be ridden on private property, NOT public sidewalks, streets, or trails

E-motorcycles lack pedals

E-motorcycles require a license and registration to operate
